

Amendment to Code of Behaviour re Mobile phone use in school.

Page 10 of Code of Behaviour.

Mobile phones/Smart Devices

- Mobile phones are strictly forbidden during the school day.
- Mobile phones must be switched off and locked in the student's locker.
- Any teacher may confiscate a mobile phone if seen or heard on a student's person/used anywhere in the school or on the school grounds.
- Refusal to give the phone to the teacher will result in an **immediate suspension**.
- The phone should be fully shut down when handed to the teacher.
- Confiscated phones are given to the principal until the end of school day.
- A student will be suspended if caught with a mobile phone a second or subsequent time.
- If a student needs to contact home, they can do so through the front office.
- Should a parent/guardian need to contact a student, they can contact the school office on 021 430 3330.

Smart devices

- In line with the regulations of the State Examinations Commission, Smart devices, for example smart watches, are not allowed in examination centres. During class tests and term examinations as well as state examinations, such devices must be switched off and not brought into the examination centre.
